Letter from the Pastor

Dear Avondale Family,

It has been a wonderful start to 2022!

As I write this, I am still feeling the excitement and energy of celebrating my first Easter all together here at Avondale. For me, it truly felt like a service of Resurrection as we worshiped and visited with friends, old and new, that we have not been able to see for a while.

However, it wasn't just Easter ... Palm Sunday was wonderful for both young and old as the children participated in the Palm Parade, leading us in music, and of course the traditional Egg Hunt in the Sacred Garden. Prior to Lent, we experienced worship through the eyes of the Yakama Native Ameri-

can tradition. We were led by our Youth in worship as they helped us understand the biases that influence our perspectives in our church and in the world.

In just the first three months we helped shine

the light of Christ by meeting the needs of our Homeless Neighbors as we partnered with Roof Above and our friends at Holy Comforter. Monthly, members gathered and packed lunches for the working homeless. We held a blood drive during Holy Week and raised over \$3,000 for Ukrainian Refugees in our special offering.

Yes, God has been at work in our faith community and continues to be working. In fact, we are in

the process of integrating Children's Moment and Children's Church back into Sunday morning worship. Avondale Adventures started up for the spring. We are planning Vacation Bible School for



the summer, and a new Confirmation Class begins the first of May. Youth are preparing for their Mission Trip and the Youth Conference at Montreat. Sacred Space is moving forward and working with Church Interiors on a new permanent worship space. Leadership is working on Visioning for Avondale and discerning where God is calling us in this new season of ministry.

- Participation in Avondale Adventures







ACE Summer Camps will be held on Avondale's campus from June 21 through August 5, Monday through Friday, 8 AM



Thanks to an immediate and enthusiastic volunteer response, we easily staffed RITI throughout the season and had no COVID cases reported.

throughout the season. Mahlon graciously offered to even drive the weeks that our neighbor churches, St. Luke's Lutheran and Sedgefield Methodist, hosted guests. Rich Worf led Room In The Inn for a second year and we are indebted for his capable oversight and leadership.













